The Louisa County Farm Bureau at their annual meeting with over 100 in attendance voted unanimously to pass resolution no. 1 in the news article to the right. "We support that Lake Odessa be managed as a multipurpose area to benefit all interests - duck hunting, fishing, boating, birders, canoe and cabin owners, rather than it's single purpose current use". This item was discussed separately from all the other items and it passed unanimously. The single purpose referred to was duck hunting. Duck hunting, fishing, boating, bird watching, canoeing, and cabin dwelling can coexist.

Local

 We support that Lake Odessa be managed as a multipurpose recreation area to benefit all interests - duck hunting, fishing, boating, birders, canoe and cabin owners, rather than it's single purpose current use.

State

We support the right to kill mountain lions on sight without consulting the Iowa DNR or any other agency.

Ethanol:

 We support requiring all gas stations to sell 10 percent or 20 percent ethanol based gasoline.
